

## SAFETY FIRE ALERT REMINDER

We have left this at many yards that reported to have mini bon fires or just open fire with no safety pit- please take the following to heart as we do not want to see KHA burned to the ground.

Fire hazard danger should always be treated as high level-so ***if you do not need to have an open fire-don't.*** If you do it is very important to remember the steps that need to be adhered to, especially if there have been several hot days and no rain.

- Notify the Police department and let them know the address and time frame you are going to have the fire (unless it is a fire to cook on)
- Have the fire in an acceptable pit to retain the fire--**NEVER ON A COMBUSTIBLE DECK OR NEAR DRY WOOD OR BARE BRANCHES**
- The pit should be in an area that the space above it is clear, not among the trees or under the overhang of tree branches or pile of dry brush-(you are asking for a fire in either case)
- Have the height of the fire at a safe level to minimize sparks flying into the air-no 2-3 foot high bon fires
- Contain fire with a screen (unless cooking) to prevent sparks and burning ashes from flying into any dry trees, wood decks, structures or underbrush.
- Have a working fire hose next to the fire
- Do not leave the fire unattended at any time for any reason

The house you save from burning may not be just your own but several of your neighbors homes also. If you rent the house please leave a copy of this somewhere that it can be easily seen.
